The following CKC regular conformation classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

- Junior Puppy:** dogs - 6 months of age/under 9 months
Senior Puppy: dogs - 9 months of age/under 12 months
12- 18 month: dogs - 12 months of age/under 18 months
Canadian Bred: dogs - born in Canada, champions in any country excluded
Bred by Exhibitor: dogs - owned and handled in the ring by the breeder
Open: for all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the CKC
Veteran: any dog over 7 years of age

Specials Only: dogs which are **registered individually** in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have an ERN (Event Registration Number) and have attained championship status may be entered in the "Specials Only" Class. Entry of a dog in "Specials Only" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the C.K.C., but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be canceled.

Award of Merit, one award for every 10 dog competing at the Best of Breed level.

Trophies and Ribbons

Obedience

Borzoi Canada is offering a prize for the highest scoring Borzoi entered in each of the five obedience trials and five Rally obedience events. Rally award is unofficial and based on score, ties determined by time.

Sweepstakes Classes: Divided by sex, 6-9 month, 9-12 month, 12-18 month, Veteran 7-9 years, 9 years and older. A dog entered in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Official Class.

Sweepstakes Prizes: 1st Place 30%, 2nd Place 20%, 3rd Place 15%, 4th Place 10% for each class. A rosette will be awarded for Best In Sweepstakes, Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes. ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - ERN NUMBERS

Effective Jan. 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an event registration number (ERN). This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or VISA/Mastercard number, (expiry date, cardholders

name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of ERN number. Cost \$55.00. ERN number must be applied for within 30 DAYS of the FIRST day of entering a CKC event.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
2. ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED AFTER CLOSING DATE. Receipts, judging schedules, and exhibitors passes will be mailed, or can be retrieved from www.thedogshow.ca
3. 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
4. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS. You are responsible for cleaning up if you permit your dog to relieve itself outside the show building. Failure to do so may result in being expelled from the building for one day's showing by the Superintendent.
5. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
6. SHOW PRECINCTS: Edmonton Northlands Agricom Halls A & B excluding the commercial booth space and the front foyer.
7. "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

* includes the dog awarded Winners


In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.


To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule as set forth above.

The new system provides for additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog, either at the breed level or at the group level, if a dog awarded WINNERS also placed in the Group, as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than 5 points at any single show.
